

# **Baseball Manitoba**

## **Member In Good Standing**

For the purpose of this document, the term “Association” refers to:

- Community based association
- League Association
- Provincial Baseball Association (Baseball Manitoba)
- Western Baseball Association (Western Canada Baseball Association)
- National Baseball Association (Baseball Canada)

A Member shall be deemed to be In Good Standing provided they have:

- a) paid membership dues, registration fees or payments as prescribed by the Association
- b) they have complied with the Constitution, By-laws and Policies of the Association
- c) they are not subject to a disciplinary investigation or action of the Association
- d) they have not voluntarily withdrawn from membership
- e) they have not been expelled, or suspended

Failing any of these criteria may put a member into Not In Good Standing.

A member Not In Good Standing is ineligible for any benefits that members are entitled to including, but not limited to:

- Ineligible to compete, coach or umpire or take part in any programs
- Ineligible to attend Association meetings
- Ineligible to register to compete, coach or umpire
- Ineligible to receive any funding programs
- Ineligible to attend player, coach or official clinics
- Is not covered by Baseball Manitoba insurance

If an Association deems a member to be Not In Good Standing, they must inform Baseball Manitoba of that decision immediately.
